- PHSCE support
- Literacy (spelling, phonics, grammar, reading and writing)
- Numeracy (all operations)

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

- **92.8% of pupils eligible for PPG attained ARE (Age Related Expected) in Reading**
- **82.2% of pupils eligible for PPG attained ARE (Age Related Expected) in Writing**
- **92.8% of pupils eligible for PPG attained ARE (Age Related Expected) in Numeracy**
- Strong support and rapport network with families through FSW. Parents meet regularly with FSW to access resources and workshops run on school site.
- Coffee mornings, Share courses and workshops accessed throughout the year.
- Recent educational visits have been funded to allow access for eligible pupils. PGL (residential) holiday being one such example.
- Interventions have been implemented to further narrow the gap in attainment.
- Extra-curricular funding of Recorder and Guitar provided
